WHEREAS, the facilities of Westminster Canterbury Richmond are home to a large retirement community adjacent to the Bellevue neighborhood on the North Side of the city of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, because these facilities are located in a populous residential area, it is in the interest of those persons residing in such facilities and in the surrounding area that the City fully explore all needed transportation improvements and available traffic calming measures that will maintain or improve the quality of life in this community; and

WHEREAS, concerns for the public safety have arisen given the pedestrian traffic in this area and the use of Pope Avenue as a “cut-through” street to access Westbrook Avenue; and


NOW, THEREFORE,
